



CLUB RULES

Registration. All golfers and guests shall register at the Clubhouse before entering the Course. Club may ask for ID.

Fees. Playing without paying the fees will cause expulsion from the Course.

Carts: Cart rental is for ½ cart only. Golfers must have valid driver licenses to operate golf carts. Golfers must share cart if playing together. Golfers shall disclose if there is a rider and pay the rider fee. Club may impose a single-rider surcharge on busy weekends/holidays and also when someone refuses to share cart while playing with others. If cart is slowing down or stopped, call the Clubhouse and we will bring another cart to you. Abandoning a cart at the Course and not informing the Clubhouse is considered property damage and is grounds for being banned from future play.

Alcoholic Beverages. No alcoholic beverages may be brought on to or taken off the property. There is a \$500 fine for each offence.

Smoking. The Clubhouse is a non-smoking facility.

Personal Belongings. Lost and found golf clubs and electronic items will be held for 1 month and then disposed off.

Dress Code: Men: Shirts with collar, nice pants or shorts. Women: collared or sleeveless golf tops, and bottoms like tailored shorts, skorts, skirts, or pants. For all: Only soft spikes or spike-less shoes.

Safety and Accidents. Please report any unsafe conditions or accidents to a Club staff member. If there is an emergency, call 911, tend to the individual's needs, and seek help.

Injuries and Property Damage: Golfers and guests are responsible for injuries and property damages caused by them.

Rain Check Policy. Rain checks redeemable for play at a later date may be issued at the sole discretion of the pro shop staff. Alternatively, a credit may be issued which is computed on a per-hole basis (13.3 minutes/hole and crediting the remaining holes).

COURSE RULES

MOTTO: EVERY GOLFER AND THEIR TIME IS RESPECTED

- ❖ On weekends and holidays, no more than 4 golfers in a group until 2 PM. Other times, 5 or 6-somes may be allowed at the discretion of the management.
- ❖ Groups must consolidate into a 2 carts per foursome and 1 cart for twosome of riding golfers.
- ❖ Walking is not allowed during busy times as determined by CLUB management. Also no walking allowed during weekends & holidays until 2 PM.
- ❖ Play is expected to be at a pace of 12 minutes per hole or less. Players should not spend more than 5 minutes searching for golf balls. Allow faster groups to play through at the earliest opportunity. During weekends and holidays until 2 PM, all golfers are expected to finish 18-holes in 4 hours and 9 holes in 2 hours.
- ❖ All players are required to have their own golf club sets unless permitted by the staff.
- ❖ Golfers between the ages of 6 and 15 years must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older).
- ❖ Observe 90⁰ rule near greens and tee boxes. Golf carts may not travel within 30 yards of putting surfaces.
- ❖ Repair ball marks on putting surfaces and rake sand bunkers. Replace divots and use sand mixture to smooth it out.
- ❖ Range/Practice balls are not allowed to be used on the golf course.
- ❖ Players/companions are not allowed to enter the driving range to retrieve range balls.
- ❖ USGA rules govern play.
